The famous "Screaming Eagles" Airborne Division was resting at Reims after a hard fought Market-Garden Campaign when the call came to head for the front. The paratroopers were trucked to Bastogne, arriving on December 19, just in time to hold the town. CCB of the 10th Armored and a few other units were attached to the 101st and, even though surrounded and cut off from supply for several days by the Germans and under frequent attack, they managed to hold the critical intersection and severely limit the advance of the Germans in the center of the bulge. This campaign was the last real fight of the war for the Screaming Eagles.
