The 10th Armored Division (known as “Tiger”) had only been on the continent for a couple of months and was part of Patton’s Third Army to the south. The division was headed for the Saar offensive after having helped take Metz when the order came on Dec 17 to head north. It was the first Third Army unit sent and its commander decided to send a reinforced CCB to Bastogne while CCA went to help the hard pressed 28th Infantry Division. CCR was combined with CCA of the 9th Armored and the 109th Regiment from the 28th Infantry to form CCX. These scattered pieces of the division all saw hard fighting.
