The Finns didn't have any large tank formations in their army at this time but used captured tanks in support of their infantry. These tanks should probably not appear any more than one company at a time (3 counters) and would consist of the Vickers 6 ton, T-26E, T-38, and the BA-10 armored car. They had captured a number of BT-5/BT-7 tanks as well but they considered them too unreliable for combat use.
